Public Housing was established to provide decent and safe rental housing for eligible and low-income families, the elderly, and persons with disabilities. Public Housing comes in all sizes and types, from scattered single family houses to high rise apartments for elderly families. The U.S. Department of Housing and urban development (better known as HUD) administers federal aid to local housing agencies that manage the housing for low income residents, at rent they can afford. In this program, your rent is generally 30% of your monthly income after allowances for such things as dependents and medical expenses. If you pay your own utilities, an allowance will be subtracted from your rent.

- Edison Court consist of 42 Efficiency units, which have an open concept for easy accessibility.
- Efficiency is defined as an apartment in which one room typically contains the kitchen, living, and sleeping quarters, with a separate bathroom.
- You must be deemed elderly or disabled at the time the application is completed, if NOT your application will be DENIED.
- A Laundry Room and Community Center are located onsite

Thank you for applying for the Baytown Housing Authority Waiting List. In a continuing effort to provide the most up to date information, we ask that you follow these simple rules in order to keep the waiting list current and moving in an efficient manner.

- **Please come to our office with a valid picture I.D. in order to check your status. No information will be given over the phone. No exceptions.**
- **You must come in person to check your status, no one can come for you.**
- **Come in person to report any change in address, phone number or household size. (you have ten(10) days to report this change)**
- **Any mail sent out and returned by the post office or left unanswered will result in your application being withdrawn from the waiting list.**
- **Mailed annual update forms must be returned by the due date stated or your application will be withdrawn from the waiting list.**
